Event Rules & Regulations

For the safety and security of the participants the following event rules and regulations are in effect:

At the door:

- Valid high school identification along with an event ticket is required for entry.
- Bags and/or coats will be searched upon entering the event. Items such as pillows and blankets are not permitted.
- No entry to the event after 12:30 a.m. (doors open at 11:45 p.m.).
- Anyone displaying evidence of alcohol and/or illegal substance use upon arrival will not be permitted to the event. Any cigarettes and lighters will be confiscated before entering the theaters.
- **NO REFUND ON TICKETS.**
- If a participant requires prescription medication they must be accompanied by a parent/guardian upon entering the building.

At the event:

- This is a locked-in event. The doors will open at 7 am Saturday morning. There will be no exiting once you have entered the building.
- No alcohol and/or illegal substances permitted.
- No outside beverages or snacks will be permitted.

- Participants may bring in healthy snacks.
- No weapons permitted.
- This is a non-smoking event.
- Loitering outside the building will not be permitted.
- Seating for each show is on first-come, first-serve basis.

NOTE: Should a participant under the age of 18 wish to leave the event for any reason, a security team member is required to call home and speak with a parent/guardian. This is to ensure that safe transportation arrangements have been made before a participant is allowed to leave the premises. If we are not able to reach a parent/guardian, the participant is required to stay until 7 a.m. Participants over the age of 18 can leave any time, but will NOT be re-admitted.

Safety & Security

It is important for everyone to know that safety and security are the main concerns during this event for all those involved. There will be a team of 20 trained Adult Event Volunteers. There will also be two uniformed Police Officers and St. John Ambulance volunteers.

If at any time you feel unsafe during the event because of a situation or person(s), do not hesitate to alert a security volunteer no matter what the situation or who the person(s) involved is. We will do everything we can to ensure you have a positive experience at this event.

Food

Consumable items included in the ticket price are fountain pop, water and popcorn. Packaged goods such as candy bars, confectionery items, bottled juices, etc. will not be available for purchase.
