1. What is Speaker's Bureau? How can I use it in my workplace?

United Way Guelph Wellington Dufferin's Speaker's Bureau is an opportunity for you and your team to learn how your donations are used to create shared social good in our community.

Our staff team will connect with an Impact Speaker from our funded agencies to come to your place of work or attend virtually and will speak to your team about the impact their donation has on the communities they serve.

2. How do I book an Impact Speaker to come to my workplace?

If you are interested in booking an impact speaker to speak to your team, please fill out [our request form](#), with the date, time and location of your meeting. If you are interested in hearing from a speaker from a specific one of our Focus Areas, please indicate so on the sign-up form.

We aim to confirm to all speaker requests at least 2 weeks in advance of your meeting.

3. How long should I set aside for an Impact Speaker?

Speakers will typically speak for 10 to 15 minutes. We suggest scheduling at least 20 minutes for them, to allow for any questions and buffer time.

4. What information do I need to provide?

Please include the date and time of when you would like an Impact Speaker to come. Please provide as much detail as possible about the location of your meeting, including which door the speaker should enter through and if they are required to check-in with a visitor's desk.
